1. Ethics Policy 008
Mr. Ritter decided to withdraw his proposal for a ELSD Ethics 008 Policy after further consideration. The committee agreed.
2. Doctrine for Board Governance & Leadership 011
Mr. Ritter reviewed proposal Policy 011 to replace the current policy created by PSBA. The committee agreed to move the local policy forward for Board consideration.
3. Electronic Devices 237
Mr. Ritter discussed the committee's desire for a bell-to-bell electronic device free school for the 2026-27 school term. Further recommendations from Mr. Ritter on including all personal electronic devices such as smart watches, earbuds, smart glasses, and smart pens as examples for exclusion. The committee agreed to pause for Legislative action before advancing a local policy but to prepare a draft policy for May / June.
4. Administrative Regulations 907 Classroom Visits by Parents and Board Members
Dr. Stamm shared with the committee that he was developing ARs for both parent and board classroom visits that would be shared with the board in March.
5. Field Trips 121
Mrs. Hopkins requested discussion on chaperones for elementary field trips and the possibility of allowing more or any parent to attend rather than limiting to a set number. Dr. Stamm presented concerns for managing more chaperones and equity across all three elementary schools.
