We submit our letter of intent to continue providing legal services to the District. We offer a fee structure which represents small increases in the hourly and meeting rates as follows:

- Attorney time for professional services, \$150.00 per hour;
- Paralegal services, \$80.00 per hour;
- Attendance at regularly-scheduled board meetings, \$375.00 per meeting, plus mileage costs at the IRS rate, or \$225.00 per meeting that are less than 1.5 hours in length;
- Reimbursement for all out-of-pocket expenses incurred on behalf of the East Lycoming School District, including photocopying at the rate of \$.25 per page; overnight delivery and bulk mailings (if required); court costs, if any; and computerized legal research, if utilized; as well as travel other than for regularly-scheduled Board meetings.

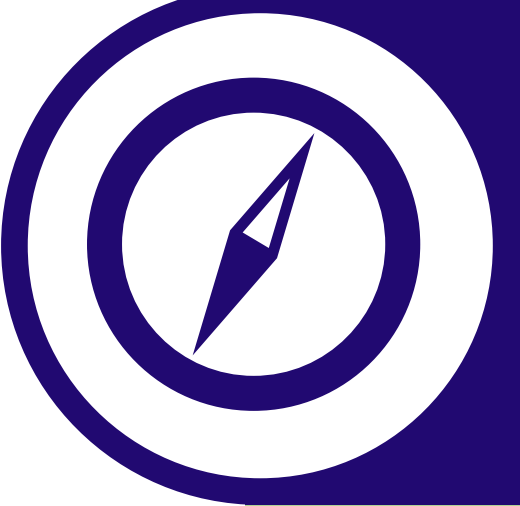
# Pennsylvania School Boards Association PRINCIPLES FOR GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP
